
PUTTING THE HEART OF THE TRAVELER IN THE SOUL OF THE PLACE

Wolves, foxes, elk, bison, moose, bighorn sheep, river otters, birds, and other creatures are active in the sparkling, snowy expanses.

Commune with the nature of winter on guided explorations through geothermal features and the surrounding forest.
